

Red Prints Web Bonus: Pillowcase

Finished Pillowcase Size

21" x 32"

shop*

#1 print (wide border) 1/2 yd.

#2 print (narrow border) 1/8 yd.

#3 print (body of pillowcase) 7/8 yd.

*Yardages and cutting instructions are for 1 pillowcase. Yardages are based on usable fabric widths of at least 42 1/2".

cut

#1 print
1 strip 11" x 42 1/2"

#2 print
1 strip 1 1/2" x 42 1/2"

#3 print
1 rectangle 26 3/4" x 42 1/2"

sew

1 Stitch together 11" and 1 1/2" strips and 26 3/4" rectangle along long sides (**Diagram I**). Fold pieced rectangle in half, right sides together, as shown by dashed line.

2 Sew 1/4" seam along pillowcase bottom and side (**Diagram II**).

3 Press 1/4" to wrong side of 11" strip (**Diagram III**). Fold pressed edge to just cover seam line between 1 1/2" strip and 26 3/4" rectangle, enclosing raw edges, and press again. Pin in place from right side of pillowcase.

4 To complete pillowcase, turn right side out and sew along seam line between 1 1/2" strip and 26 3/4" rectangle, being sure to catch folded edge in stitching.

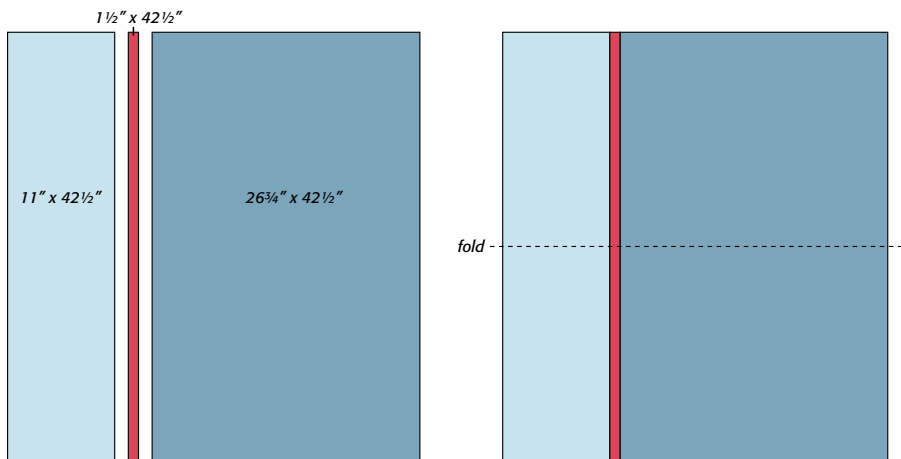

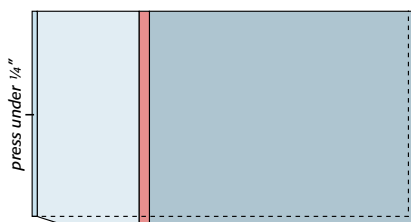
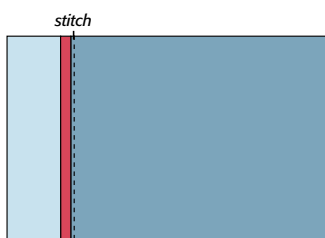
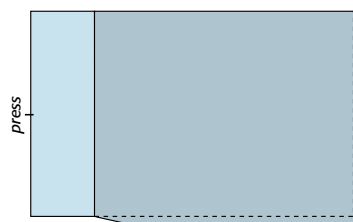
