shop

Cream/black check **and** green/black check (four-patches) 1 fat eighth* **each**
 Pinecone print (squares) 11" x 11" piece
 Burgundy/black check (border, pillow back) 1 fat quarter**
 Pillow form, 14" square
 *A fat eighth is a 9" x 20-22" cut of fabric.
 **A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

cut

Cream/black check **and** green/black check—**cut from each:**
 10 squares 2½" x 2½"
 Pinecone print
 4 squares 4½" x 4½"
 Burgundy/black check
 *1 square 14½" x 14½"
 2 strips 1½" x 12½"
 2 strips 1½" x 14½"
 *Cut first.

sew

1 Sew together 2 cream/black check and 2 green/black check 2½" squares to make four-patch (**Diagram I**). Make 5.

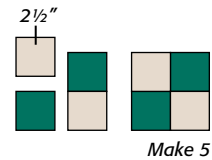

2 Referring to **Diagram II**, sew 3 rows using 5 four-patches and 4 pinecone print 4½" squares. Sew rows together. Stitch burgundy check 12½" strips to sides. Add burgundy check 14½" strips to top and bottom to complete pillow front.

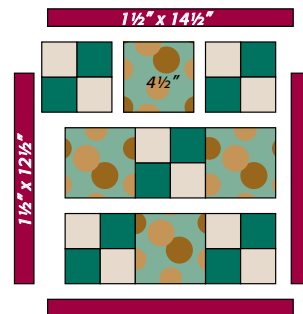

3 Trim all 4 corners of pillow front as shown in **Diagram III**. Repeat to trim corners of pillow back.

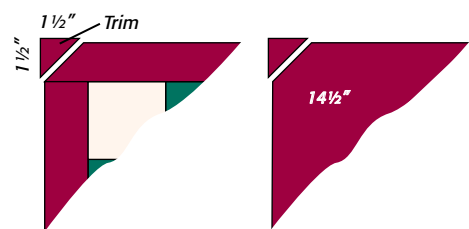

4 Layer trimmed pillow front and back, right sides together and raw edges aligned. Stitch around edges, pivoting at corners and leaving opening on 1 side (**Diagram IV**). Turn right side out through opening; press.

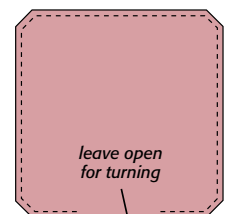

5 Insert pillow form in cover. Hand stitch opening closed.
